

Suggested items to bring with you on your boating holiday

- Soft bags instead of suitcases, as there is not much storage space on the boat
- Torches for darkened towpaths in the evening
- Trainers / non-slip rubber soles
- Waterproofs – we provide one set
- Golfing umbrella – we provide one umbrella
- Clothes for all types of weather – it's better to have layers of clothing rather than just one thick one
- 2 or 3 long sleeved tops to keep out the wind
- Jeans / shorts / comfortable trousers
- Baseball cap / hat
- Gloves
- DVD's and CD's
- Games (Monopoly, cards etc...)
- Bread, butter, snacks, drinks, breakfast items etc...
- Dried or tinned foods where possible as they are much easier to store
- Coffee, tea, sugar, cooking oil, sauces, foil, cling film etc...
- Towels – we provide a hand towel
- Sunglasses and sun cream
- Anti insect cream / spray
- Extra loo rolls, not too thick a ply as they can block the loo – we provide 4 rolls
- We always recommend boiling the water rather than drinking it straight from the taps on the boat, therefore you may wish to bring bottled water, or a water container to fill up from taps along the way. There will be one bottle of water on-board.
- Camera / video
- Binoculars
- Toothpaste and brush
- Hand cream
- Any personal medication
- Reading glasses
- Slippers or warm socks
- We regret that bicycles are not allowed
- For pets remember – beds, food, bowls, leads, collars, towels, brush, old blankets, doggie buoyancy aids if needed
- Address, directions and telephone number for Castle Narrowboats
